# **1.Introduction**

### Welcome

#### Welcome to MS Group.

Please do not leave your group and stay with your contact person or your visitor group during your entire visit of the factory premises.

# 2. RULES OF CONDUCT

### 2.1 Access restriction



Entering areas, departments, machines and equipment is strictly prohibited and only possible after express consent by your contact person!

### 2.2 Smoking



Observe the non-smoking rules, especially in the areas exposed to fire hazard!

### 2.3 Food and beverages



Do not take any food or beverages to the production areas.

## 2.4 Alcohol and drugs



It is not permitted to bring and consume alcoholic beverages and other intoxicants!

## 2.5 Cardiac Pacemakers



In the designated areas, persons with cardiac pacemakers and implants are particularly at risk. Keep your distance!

## 2.6 Photographing



It is not allowed to film and photograph machines or operating facilities!

2.7 Rules on company premises

### 2.8 Personal protective equipment



During your visit of the factory premises, please wear sturdy shoes within the marked paths and safety shoes outside of these paths!



Use hearing protection in designated noise sectors!



Use safety goggles in designated areas!

### 2.9 General Information



On staircases, please use handrails.

MS Group is not responsible for your safety-related basic knowledge or instruction. Should you not be able to provide proof of safety-related instructions, which are the prerequisite for your safe stay on the premises of MS Group, you are not allowed to enter the production facilities.

# 3. HAZARD WARNINGS



Do not step under suspended loads!

Suspended loads



Do not enter any closed-off areas and use the marked paths!

Closed-off areas



Watch out for trip hazards!

Danger of tripping



Danger of slipping due to wet or oily floor!

Pay attention to forklift traffic!

Please do not touch any equipment, moving machine parts, construction materials, chemicals or other items in the production facilities.

# 4. EMERGENCY

Behavior in case of fire, accidents and other hazards:

#### 4.1 Emergency Call



In case of emergencies, please immediately contact our staff; we can help you with our competent first aiders.

In case of fire, immediately leave the building via the designated escape routes; remember to inform your companions.

#### 4.2 Escape and rescue route



Make sure that you are aware of your location and the nearest escape routes. Please do not separate from the person accompanying you unless this has been expressly agreed.

#### **4.3 Meeting Point**



Plans with escape routes have been put up in different places within the company. The meeting point is in front of the gate (parking lot).

## 4.4 Authority

The instructions of the rescue and work safety teams must be followed!
